




Nakasendo, Kawagoe Kaido, Mikuni Kaido / Green Route

1 Matsumoto Soy Sauce Shop

A historic soy sauce brewery in Koedo Kawagoe, crafting soy sauce in traditional wooden barrels since the Edo period. Visitors can see the art of fermentation and skilled craftsmanship up close.

Oshi Castle is one of the seven most famous castles in the Kanto area. It is called the "Floating Castle" because it survived a flood in the late 16th century. The castle is also a popular spot for cherry blossom viewing in spring.
