




Nikko & Ōshū Kaido, Sakura & Narita Kaido, Mito Kaido / Green Route

Highlights

◆ Walk through castle towns, post towns, and traditional warehouse districts to encounter the history and daily life of the Kanto region that has continued since the Edo period.

◆ Cycle or stroll through paths lined with cherry blossoms at the foot of Mt. Tsukuba and within its parks, feeling the soft spring air with all five senses.

◆ Experience the blessings of the land through food, aromas, and wine, and savor the local food culture rooted in the region.

Day 1

AM

From Sakura Station

By Car 5 min or On Foot 15 min

① Kimono Stroll in the Castle Town
Stroll through Sakura, a castle town during the Edo period, while wearing a kimono. Visit gardens, samurai residences, bamboo groves, and the Sakura Castle Ruins Park to feel the remnants of samurai culture.

By Train 60 min

② Senju-juku
Walk with a guide through Senju-juku along the Old Nikko Kaido, which flourished as a post town during the Edo period.

② Adachi Market
At Adachi Market, enjoy a lunch featuring fresh seafood, an experience unique in dedicated fish markets.

By Train 60 min

Staying in Tochigi City

③ Kuranomachi Promenade
Stroll through the atmospheric streets while admiring the scenery of the heavy, yet beautiful traditional warehouses (Kura) lining the Uzuma River.

Day 2

AM

From Tochigi Station

By Train 30 min or By Car 30 min or By Train & Bus 60 min

④ Ashikaga Flower Park
Visit one of Japan's premier flower parks to view over 350 wisteria trees during the signature event, "Fuji no Hana Monogatari" (The Tale of the Wisteria). (Peak season: mid-April to early May).

④ Coco Farm & Winery
Visit a winery that has built the culture of Japanese wine, together with the "Kokoromi-gakuen" support facility for people with disabilities. Enjoy lunch and wine tasting while learning about their initiatives as a social farm.

AM

⑤ Tsukuba Shrine & Mt. Tsukuba Ropeway
Experience the spiritual faith and rich nature of Mt. Tsukuba, one of Japan's 100 Famous Mountains. Enjoy a grand panoramic view of the Kanto Plain from the summit station.

By Car 40 min

⑥ Ibaraki Flower Park
A floral paradise boasting 900 varieties of roses. Experience the charm of roses with all five senses through aroma-themed exhibits and an aroma mist-making workshop.

By Car 40 min

⑦ Kasumigaura Cycling
Feel the seasonal nature while riding on well-maintained, flat, and easy-to-ride paths. In spring, enjoy a pleasant cycle along the beautiful cherry blossom-lined roads. (Peak season: late March to early April)

On Foot 15 min

⑦ Tsuchiura-juku
Stroll through the historic streets of Tsuchiura-shuku, once a hub for water transport. Visit Tsuchiura Castle and Nakajo-dori to encounter the culture and remnants of the Edo period.
