




# Tokaido, Nakahara Kaido, Kamakura Kaido / Green Route

#### ① Kyu-Shiba-rikyu Gardens

Stroll through one of the premier daimyo gardens from the early Edo period. Enjoy the seasonal scenery while surrounded by nature and history that makes you forget you are in the heart of the city.

#### ② Senzoku-ike Park

Visit a historic site associated with Katsu Kaishu and Saigo Takamori, prominent figures in Japan's modern history. Enjoy the scenery where nature and history coexist in a park filled with lush greenery and a beautiful pond.

#### ③ Jingshita Keikoku Park

Witness the only park in Yokohama known as a "valley," which has a history dating back to the Kamakura period. You can enjoy a guided walk amidst rich nature that makes it hard to believe you are within the city.

## Highlights

◆ A quiet daimyo garden from the early Edo period, where you can enjoy strolling around hills and ponds that retain their historical charm.

◆ A healing walk through history along a path where lush trees and the sound of the stream bring coolness to the only "valley" in Yokohama.

◆ A refreshing stroll in Koroyama Park, offering 360-degree panoramic views of Shonandaira, Mt. Fuji, and the magnificent Sagami Bay.

#### ④ Komayama Park

Experience a nature-rich park spread across the highlands. From the observation spot known as Shonandaira, you can enjoy a famous view overlooking Mt. Fuji, Sagami Bay, and the Izu Peninsula.

#### ⑤ Odawara Castle

Odawara Castle was the stronghold of the Hojo clan, a prestigious family that ruled this region during the Warring States period. Walk through the castle ruins to feel the history up close and learn about the origins of the castle town while enjoying the surrounding views.

#### ⑤ Seikan-tei Garden

A Japanese garden known as the former villa of a prominent politician of modern Japan. You can enjoy dishes made with local Odawara ingredients and traditional crafts while overlooking the town and the sea.
